Jeju Island, Conference and Doctoral Consortium Venue



Discover one of "New 7 Wonders of Nature"

Jeju Island, selected as one of "New 7 Wonders of Nature" (<http://www.new7wonders.com/>), is one of the most beautiful islands in East Asia. Jeju Island is located just one hour by air from Seoul, capital of the Republic of Korea. It remains one of the top honeymoon destinations for Korean newlyweds. The island's mixture of volcanic rock, frequent rains, and temperate climate, make it very similar to the Hawaiian Islands in the U.S. The island offers visitors a wide range of activities: hiking on Mt. Halla-san (South Korea's highest peak), catching sunrises and sunsets over the ocean, viewing majestic waterfalls, riding horses, or just lying around on the sandy beaches.

The main PACIS 2013 conference will be conducted at **ICC-JEJU (International Convention Center in Jeju)**. ICC-JEJU is located within the Jungmun Resort Complex, with the cobalt-blue Northern Pacific stretching to the south and towering Mt. Halla-san commanding the north. Since its opening in March of 2003, the ICC-JEJU has attracted major corporate, associations, and political leaders to its doorstep. The ICC-JEJU was a venue for ASEAN-KOREA CEO Summit, which was held in May 2009 in Jeju Island. The main conference hotel will be the **Shilla Hotel Jeju**, which is located near the conference venue. The Doctoral Consortium will be held in the **Seogwipo KAL Hotel**, located at the warm southern tip of Jeju Island. It overlooks the Pacific Ocean, Mt. Halla-san and a gentle stream flowing down into the ocean. The Seogwipo KAL Hotel hailed as the first resort to promote the Jeju Olle, Jeju's historical walking paths.
